Standout Traits

Voronin's most defining asset is his elite straight-line speed. Voronin was consistently the fastest player on the ice in every game I attended – both with and without the puck. His acceleration allows him to attack through the middle of the ice and generate breakaways or partial breakaways on his own. His finishing ability is still developing, but his offensive production this season reflects meaningful progress.

His defensive motor is equally notable. On multiple occasions, the player hustling back to break up a play or strip a puck was Voronin. His commitment to backchecking stands out at the junior level. Despite being listed at 5'11", 172 lbs, he competes hard in corners, engages physically, and shows a feisty edge without crossing the line.

Projection

Voronin likely went undrafted due to modest point totals earlier in his junior career. However, posting a point-per-game season as a 19-year-old – combined with his speed, work ethic, and defensive reliability – suggests he has the tools to continue progressing. His NCAA development path will be worth monitoring over the next one to two seasons. With continued growth in his finishing and strength, he has the potential to become an effective third-line contributor at the pro level and may be an overlooked asset.
